The Deal: We've had a couple of SPA contests at Auburn but never had an Antique class so it's our first ever in that category. It will be an easy going, fun event for any airplane that falls into the Antique category currently on the SPA web site. If it's on there, you can fly it. Because the sun continues to rise in the East, we will start a bit later in the day, 9:30 should be good for the first takeoff. Any earlier and we will have to fly 90 degrees to the runway in the first round. Lunch will be provided by the ever famous Mama Goldberg's and the complete menu will be available. Lunch is included in your entry fee and will be \$7.00 for everyone else. Our field is about 800 feet of grass cut for R/C use with another 900+ cut for full size aircraft. Sistrunk Field is a private field that sees occasional use by the big planes, some of which hangar there if you care to take a look. You can get there anytime and fly all you want. We'll keep Friday reserved for pattern practice. Plenty of space for camping and RV's but no power hookups are available. There will be PortaJohns on site and there is a pond available for bathing. For the less adventurous there are several good hotels on South College Street about 12 miles away at Exit 51 off I-85. I recommend the Holiday Inn Express. Not the cheapest but reasonable and very nice. I'll announce a contest rate on the SPA list soon. Lots of good restaurants close by but I expect to have a room reserved for us at Good 'Ol Boys, some of the best country cooking around. Entry fee for the contest will be \$25.
